Fundraising Ideas

We could also put the list on the back of the shirt so other people can read it too. This, however, would cost more money. The YT tabled the idea for now and we will discuss further at the next meeting.

3. Pam Marquez offered to sell a print to the YT at cost from "Home and Garden Party" to raffle off at the YT Show. The YT discussed getting a cheaper print and selling it at an earlier show to see how much money we raised. For now, the members tabled the idea.

4. Musical Carrots 50/50 Raffle: During intermission, at the YT Show, a horse would be free lunged to music in the ring. Everyone is standing at the outside of the rail holding their ticket, which is a carrot. When the music stops, the person lunging the horse stops. If your carrot gets eaten, then you get half the money. The YT voted and decided to definitely do this!
