- We would like to remind all that the use of profanity in or out of the ring, as well as any act of cruelty to a horse or pony will not be tolerated. If you witness this please bring this to the attention of any of BOD or the staff in the Secretary's Booth ASAP so it can be addressed.
- Please use ring courtesy at all times. This applies to both the warm-up ring as well as the show ring. Passing at a safe distance from your fellow exhibitors and not riding to close to the horse in front of you will keep everyone safe. Also we don't see it a lot but beware of a horse with a Red Ribbon in their tail, this horse might kick if you get to close.
- Please be sure children are attended to at all times.
- Remember you can leave a copy of your Coggins and Rabies at the Secretary Booth so you will not need to bring them to the booth.
