Any stall left dirty the owner will be charged a fee of \$30.00 for cleaning.

There have been some concerns regarding ring courtesy. Please use ring courtesy at all times. This applies to both the warm-up ring as well as the show ring. Passing at a safe distance from your fellow exhibitors and not riding to close to the horse in front of you will keep everyone safe. Also we don't see it a lot but beware of a horse with a Red Ribbon in their tail, this horse might kick if you get to close. Please be sure children are attended to at all times. Please exercise caution when moving on the metal bleachers. The noise can spook a Horse passing by.
