## Show Rules

1. A Rabies Certificate & Negative Coggins must either be presented at all shows or a copy must be on file at the secretary booth before a horse will be allowed to enter any classes at a show. The horse's name on the Rabies Certificate & Coggins must match the registered name registered with the club.
2. SNEHA rules shall apply in all classes.
3. SNEHA Show Committee and Property Owners will not be responsible for injury to animals, persons or damage to property of exhibitors or spectators.
4. The Judge's decision is final.
5. All ages referred to in the class list are as of January 1st of the current year.
6. No horse shall be allowed in the spectator area at any time!
7. All dogs on grounds must be leashed at all times.
8. Management reserves the right to prohibit any persons from attending or showing a horse in the ring and further to remove any person or horse from the show for just cause without being liable for compensation.
9. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy to the judge or officials on the part of the owner shall forfeit all entry fees.
10. All exhibitors wishing to discuss classes with the judge must go through the SNEHA Steward of the day.
11. Excessive whipping, spurring, unnecessary yanking on the bit, or any form of cruelty/neglect to a horse will not be tolerated and should be reported to the Show Steward.
12. Profanity in or out of the ring will not be tolerated.
13. Management reserves the right not to refund any money other than for lameness, or an injury to a horse be defined by the Steward or Veterinarian at the owner's expense.
14. All exhibitors riding a horse anywhere on the grounds in an English saddle must wear a helmet. **Helmets are allowed in all classes, at the exhibitor's discretion regardless of discipline.**
15. Proper shoes with heels are required when riding on the show grounds.
16. Proper attire is required in all classes. Please refer to the rule book for each individual discipline requirements.
17. **Exhibitor's assigned number must at all times**

- be prominently displayed on the exhibitor's back or both sides of the saddle pad. At no time should the rider's hair obscure any or all of the number. Any exhibitor entering the show ring without their number properly displayed will be automatically disqualified .**
18. A green horse is a horse in it's first or second year of showing. To be ridden by an experienced rider. Green horses may not cross-enter into any other division/class except those classes noted in the rule book.
  19. Proof of age at time of entry is mandatory for any horse to be shown Western in a snaffle bit or bosal. Horse must be 5 years of age or under.
