Preparations for the SNEHA 2010 show season will be starting soon!! Just think, before we know it we will be out in the sunshine enjoying our horses, families and friends.

Just a little about our club, SNEHA or the Southern New England Horseman's Association is an organization promoting an interest in horse shows in the New England Tri-State area. We hold ten open horse shows with an emphasis on classes for youth riders. Our goal is to provide the horse community with quality open shows.
