General Membership Meeting
Field's Memorial School
May 31, 2011

President Lynda Whaley called the meeting to order at 7:50 PM. Sadie Beatrice read the secretary's report. A motion to accept the report was made by Cheryl Stomberg, seconded by Arline Card. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

The suggestion box is finally here. It will be at all the shows and meetings.

There has been some confusion over "borrowed" and "leased" horses. If you are borrowing a horse, such as your trainers, then both people have to be members and attend the required meetings. If you are actually leasing a horse, then you need to provide lease papers to the club. The horses need to be registered with the club either on the owner's membership application or the lessee's and only the lessee has to attend the 2 meetings.

Please remember to fill out the entry forms completely and clearly. Be sure the horse's names are spelled correctly because it could affect your points. Please use the separate entry forms for

the two classic classes so it will be easier for the secretaries in the booth.

The points for the first two shows have been audited and sent to the website. If you have any questions or concerns, including misspellings, you need to contact the point recorders by June 14th or the points will stand as is.

We are currently at 94 members for the Rookie Rewards Program. We need 100.

SHOWS

May 1st – We had 79 horses and brought in \$3,004.00 in entry fees.

Bill Ritchie was the judge in the main ring. There were some complaints that he did not know the showmanship patterns. Kim Ridzon said that he told the exhibitors the wrong side of the ring, but since they all did not hear him, he didn't count it if they did it wrong. The judge does have the final say, but if he changes things everyone should be informed. He did give feed back to the kids.

Ed Golembeski – trail ring. There did not seem to be any complaints. They all thought he was very nice.

After expenses we made a profit of \$637.33. The showers at Woodstock are not available. Someone picked the locks and washed off their boots and left a muddy trail.

Arrival time is not before 5:00 so that it gives us time to tag the stalls.

May 8th – We had 74 horses and brought in \$2,668.00 in entry fees. Gary Keefe was the last minute judge in the main ring. There were complaints that he

pinned as they came in and he was very inconsistent. He did not use a pattern in the discipline class. We will need to remind all the judges about that and the team classic classes. He stood in the wrong spot and people couldn't do the patterns.

Melanie Morrison was the trail judge. There was a complaint that the green horse trail was more involved. Melanie complimented us on the trail patterns, she was glad they were more involved.

All potential obstacles are listed on the website, including the different types of bridges that may be used.

Arline Card and Teri Smith totally donated the money from the strawberry shortcake sale - \$86. Thank you both very much.

The girl that was injured at the Oneco show is doing well. She had 2 facial fractures, 2 teeth missing, and had 30 stitches. She had to be transferred to UMASS and was kept overnight.

The photographer's link is on the website. He was at the second show but didn't realize there were in and outdoor classes and he was concerned about the flash. He will bring everything with him next time. He should be able to be at the rest of them except one.

The arrival time for those grounds again is no earlier than 5:00.

NEW BUSINESS

We are thinking about having a cookout dinner at the July Falls Creek show. We will do advanced ticket sales. The information will be on the website. We

will need at least 30+ people in order to do it.

The August meeting will be our sweets and treats meeting.

We cannot have the school on June 28th so we will move the membership meeting up one week to June 21st.
