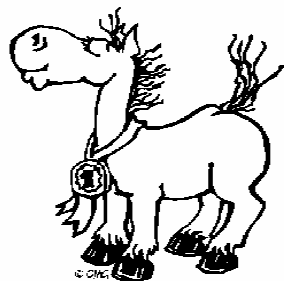
The Youth Team also discussed having a picnic / trail ride at Patchaug Forest either in addition to or instead of a fun show. Possible dates

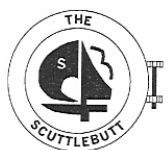
